## **Report Summary**

The Purchasing By-Law (By-Law 2014-01) requires regular information reports to the Council on the Bid Solicitations, Cooperative Purchases, Emergency Purchases and Revenue Generated Contracts Awarded with a Total Acquisition Cost or revenue of \$50,000 or more.

Contracts Awarded from April 1 – June 30, 2018 During the reporting period there were Twenty Nine (29) Contract Awards of over \$50,000, which includes three (3) Standing Offers.

Bid Solicitations are advertised electronically on the City's website in the form of either Request for Tender or Request for Proposal. Where a Request for Tender is used, the Award is to the Lowest Compliant Bid. Where a Request for Proposal is used, the Award is to the highest scored Bid based on Best Value defined as the optimal balance of performance and cost
