By-Law 2018-121

A By-law of the City of Greater Sudbury Respecting the Appointment of Officials of the City of Greater Sudbury

Whereas the *Municipal Act, 2001* and other statutes of the Province of Ontario require the appointment of officials to occupy positions within municipal government;

And Whereas Council of the City of Greater Sudbury wishes to appoint and continue the appointment of such officials and other officials for the City of Greater Sudbury;

Now therefore Council of the City of Greater Sudbury hereby enacts as follows:

Appointment - Chief Administrative Officer

- **1.-**(1) The person named in Schedule "A", Part 1 to this By-law is appointed and confirmed as the Chief Administrative Officer.
- (2) The persons named in Schedule "A", Part 2 to this By-law are appointed individually as Acting Chief Administrative Officer in the absence of the Chief Administrative Officer.

Appointments - Statutory and Other Requisite Officials

- 2.-(1) The person or persons holding the employment title identified in Column B in the chart on Schedule "B", Part 1 to this By-law are appointed and confirmed to the position described in Column A on the same line in the said chart, each such position being required by statute or for the administration of the City. Each person appointed is authorized to exercise the rights and fulfil the duties assigned to such role under the applicable legislation identified in Column A and subject to any limitations in Column A in the said chart in Schedule "B" Part 1.
- (2) The persons holding the employment title identified in Column B in the chart on Schedule "B", Part 2 to this By-law are designated and confirmed to fulfil the statutory roles identified in Column A on the same line in the said chart in Schedule "B", Part 2.
- (3) In the event that more than one person holds the employment title identified in Column B of the chart in either Schedule "B" Part 1 or Schedule "B" Part 2, each such person is appointed to the position in Column A of the chart on Schedule "B" Part 1 or designated and confirmed to fulfil the statutory role identified in Column A of the chart on Schedule "B" Part 2 as the case may be.
- (4) The appointment of a person under Schedule "B" Part 1 or Schedule "B" Part 2 shall include any person who is fulfilling the role identified in Column B of the chart, while in an acting or interim role.

Appointments - Inspectors & Enforcement Officers

- **3.-**(1) The persons named in Schedule "C", Part 1 to this By-law are appointed and confirmed as Inspectors pursuant to the *Building Code Act, 1992*, S.O. 1992, c.23.
- (2) The persons named in Schedule "C", Part 2 to this By-law are appointed as Municipal By-Law Enforcement Officers for the City for the by-laws indentified in the schedule.

Appointment - Auditor

4. The persons or firms named in Schedule "D", to this By-law have been appointed and confirmed as auditors for the City to perform the functions and duties identified in section 296 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25, for the City of Greater Sudbury and its local boards and including the City of Greater Sudbury Trust Funds. The appointment is for the fiscal years identified on the Schedule.

Duties of Officials

5. The persons appointed pursuant to this By-law shall perform such duties as may from time to time, be determined by an Act of the Legislature of the Province of Ontario, or any by-law or resolution of Council or approved job description.

Interpretation

- **6.-**(1) Whenever this By-law refers to a person or thing with reference to gender or the gender neutral, the intention is to read the By-law with the gender applicable to the circumstances.
 - (2) References to items in the plural include the singular, as applicable.
- (3) The words "include", "including" and "includes" are not to be read as limiting the phrases or descriptions that precede them.
- (4) Headings are inserted for ease of reference only and are not to be used as interpretation aids.
- (5) Specific references to laws in this By-law are printed in italic font and are meant to refer to the current laws applicable with the Province of Ontario as at the time this By-law was enacted, as they are amended from time to time.
- (6) Any reference to periods of time, stated in numbers of days, shall be deemed applicable on the first business day after a Sunday or Statutory holiday if the expiration of the time period occurs on a Sunday or Statutory holiday.

- (7) References to time in this By-law refers to local time and daylight saving time when in effect.
- (8) The obligations imposed by this By-law are in addition to obligation otherwise imposed by law or by contract.
- (9) This By-law includes the Schedules annexed hereto and the Schedules are declared to form part of this By-law.

Severability / Conflict

- 7.-(1) If any section, subsection, part or parts of this By-law is declared by any court of law to be bad, illegal or ultra vires, such section, subsection, part or parts shall be deemed to be severable and all parts hereof are declared to be separate and independent and enacted as such.
- (2) Nothing in this By-law relieves any person from complying with any provision of any Federal or Provincial legislation or any other By-law of the City.
- (3) Where a provision of this By-law conflicts with the provisions of another By-law in force in the City, the provision that establishes the higher standard to protect the health, safety and welfare of the general public shall prevail.

Repeal

- 8.-(1) By-law 2017-2 and every by-law amending By-law 2017-2 are hereby repealed.
 - (2) Where a by-law is repealed by this By-law, the repeal does not:
 - revive any by-law not in force or existing at the time of which the repeal takes effect;
 - (b) affect the previous operation of any by-law so repealed;
 - (c) affect any right, privilege, obligation or liability acquired, accrued, accruing, or incurred under the by-law so repealed;
 - (d) affect any offence committed against any by-law so repealed or any penalty or forfeiture or punishment incurred in respect thereof; or affect any investigation, legal proceeding or remedy in respect of such privilege, obligation, liability, penalty, forfeiture or punishment.

Effective Date

9. This By-law shall come into full force and effect upon passage.

Short Title

10. This By-law may be referred to as the "Appointments By-law".
