PETITION We the undersigned residents of Ward 7, O'Neil Dr. East and area neighbourhoods, are concerned about our safety on our street. We are requesting the installation of 4 way stop signs at the new intersection at Catherine St., O'Neil Drive East and Fox Ridge Drive (formerly where the playground used to be).

We have observed and experienced the following:

- 1) O'Neil Dr. East is used as a shortcut, particularly in the morning and evening, between Garson Coniston Rd. to Falconbridge Rd.
- 2) numerous complaints to the police and councillors over the past decade regarding traffic.
- 3) traffic driving out of Fox Ridge Drive and Catherine have had close calls since many "shortcutters" come whipping off Garson Coniston Rd. and already have a good head of speed before getting to the intersection.
- 4) children in our neighbourhood use the intersection to cross when walking/biking over to the new park or when returning which places them in danger without the 4-way stop.
- 5) some drivers have passed our vehicles as we are attempting to enter driveways or feeder streets.
- 6) some through traffic will sound their horns either at kids or other vehicles.

Therefore, we are requesting the installation of 4 way stop signs at the new intersection at Catherine and O'Neil Drive East and Fox Ridge Drive (formerly where the playground used to be).
