By-law 2018-77

A By-law of the City of Greater Sudbury to Authorize an Agreement with the Federation of Canadian Municipalities' Municipal Asset Management Program Grant

Whereas the Federation of Canadian Municipalities has launched a Municipal Asset Management Program to provide funding for projects that will enable municipalities to further their asset management practices;

And Whereas under the program, the Federation of Canadian Municipalities will provide funding for up to 80% of the total eligible project costs to a maximum of \$50,000 and the City of Greater Sudbury is responsible for the remaining costs;

And Whereas the City of Greater Sudbury wishes apply for funding under the Federation of Canadian Municipalities' Municipal Asset Management Program to retain a Building Science Consultant to assess the condition of existing Fire Halls and if accepted, is prepared to provide the necessary financial contribution to the proposed project;

Now therefore Council of the City of Greater Sudbury hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. The Executive Director of Finance, Assets and Fleet is hereby authorized to apply for funding from the Federation of Canadian Municipalities' Municipal Asset Management Program, and if accepted, to sign on behalf of the City of Greater Sudbury, a contribution agreement with the Federation of Canadian Municipalities, all amendments thereto, renewals, extensions and other related documents. The General Manager is further authorized to make all decisions, perform all functions required pursuant to the Agreement in order to administer and implement the terms of the Agreement.
- This By-law comes into effect upon passage.
