

**By-law 2018-46**

**A By-law of the City of Greater Sudbury  
to Authorize the Payment of Grants from the  
Healthy Community Initiative Fund, Wards 1, 2, 4, 5, 6, 9, 11 and 12**

**Whereas** pursuant to Section 107 of the *Municipal Act 2001*, S.O. 2001 c. 25, Council may pass by-laws for grants to certain bodies for purposes in the interest of the municipality;


**And Whereas** Council of the City of Greater Sudbury allocated from the capital envelope, for the year 2018, sums for expenditures from the Healthy Community Initiative Fund in accordance with By-law 2016-18 being a By-law of the City of Greater Sudbury to Adopt the Council Expense and Healthy Community Initiative Fund Policy;


**And Whereas** the Council of the City of Greater Sudbury wishes to authorize the making of certain grants in accordance with the guidelines as set out in By-law 2016-18 being a By-law of the City of Greater Sudbury to Adopt the Council Expense and Healthy Community Initiative Fund Policy;

**Now therefore Council of the City of Greater Sudbury hereby enacts as follows:**

1. Council of the City of Greater Sudbury hereby approves the payments made or to be made by way of grant, from the Healthy Community Initiatives Fund for each of the specified wards, to the organizations identified in Column A, for the purpose identified in Column B and in the amount in Column C, all as set out in the chart on Schedule "A" attached to and forming part of this By-law. These are one time grants.
2. The Treasurer is hereby authorized to make the payments by way of grants from the Healthy Community Initiatives Fund in accordance with Schedule "A" upon the written request of the General Manager of Community Development or such person as she may have authorized to request funds in her place and stead. The General Manager of Community Development is authorized to execute on behalf of the City, any agreement with a grant recipient setting out the terms of the grant.
3. This By-law shall come into full force and effect upon passage.
