By-law 2017-223

A By-law of the City of Greater Sudbury Regarding the 2016 Social Infrastructure Fund, Year 3 Allocation

Whereas the Council of the City of Greater Sudbury deems it desirable to participate in the 2016 Social Infrastructure Funding Program;

And Whereas the City wishes to authorize an agreement with the Ministry of Housing related to funding under the Social Infrastructure Funding Program for affordable housing funding initiatives for the Year 3 Allocation by the Province;

Now therefore the Council of the City of Greater Sudbury hereby enacts as follows:

1. The Manager of Housing Services is hereby authorized to administer and implement the City's Program Delivery and Fiscal Plan as approved by the Ministry of Housing under the 2016 Social Housing Infrastructure Funds, Year 3 Funding Allocation and make such decisions, and sign such agreements and related documents as may be required including without limitation authorizing the Manager of Housing Services to:

- (a) forward the City's Program Delivery and Fiscal Plan for the Social Housing Infrastructure Fund Initiatives to the Ministry of Housing for funding approval;
- (b) adjust the City's Program Delivery and Fiscal Plan for the Social Housing Infrastructure Fund Initiatives to reflect any changes required by, or recommendations of, the Ministry of Housing to secure funding approval for Year 3 funding;
- sign any agreements with the Ministry of Housing for approved Year 3 funding under components of the Social Housing Infrastructure Fund Initiatives, any related documents or reports, any amendments to or extensions of such agreements;
- (d) allocate and distribute funds received under the Social Housing Infrastructure Fund, Year 3 Funding Allocation to appropriate recipients in accordance with the City's Program Delivery and Fiscal Plan and program guidelines and agreements with the City; and
- (e) establish the form of and sign agreements and any amending agreements, with participants who have been approved to receive from the City of Greater Sudbury

funds from the Social Housing Infrastructure Fund, Year 3 Funding Allocation, and to administer and enforce such agreements.

2. The Manager of Housing Services is hereby authorized to continue to make decisions regarding allocation of funding received under received under the provincial Delivering Opportunities for Ontario Renters Program, commonly known as DOORS, to supplement the funding available under the various affordable housing programs.

3. This by-law shall come into full force and effect upon passage.
