

## By-law 2017-181

### **A By-law of the City of Greater Sudbury to Delegate Authority to the Director of Economic Development Regarding the Development of the Greater Sudbury Synergy Centre Project and the Art Gallery of Sudbury/Greater Sudbury Public Library Project**

**Whereas** by Resolution CC2017-188, Council for the City of Greater Sudbury approved a concept for a Greater Sudbury Synergy Project and by Resolution CC2017-189 approved a concept for an Art Gallery of Sudbury/Greater Sudbury Public Library Project and directed work to be commenced for a site evaluation and selection process, and further directed that a consultant be retained to develop a business plan, operational model, conceptual design and financial plan;

**And Whereas** Council for the City of Greater Sudbury wishes to delegate various authorities to the Director of Economic Development in order that the work directed under Resolutions CC2017-188 and CC2017-189 can be completed in the timeline established by Council;

**Now therefore the Council of the City of Greater Sudbury hereby enacts as follows:**

#### Delegated Authorities

1.-(1) The Director of Economic Development is delegated the authority to make and implement the decisions necessary for the completion of proposed Greater Sudbury Synergy Centre Project and the Art Gallery of Sudbury/Greater Sudbury Public Library Project, in accordance with the Business Plan, Operational Model, Conceptual Design and Financial Plan as approved or amended by Council for the City of Greater Sudbury from time to time for each such Project. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, the Director of Economic Development is authorized, within the parameters set out above:

- (a) to negotiate and to sign on behalf of the City any agreements the Director of Economic Development considers necessary, including agreements for cost sharing, and, despite the Purchasing By-law 2014-01 as amended, for non-competitive purchases with a total acquisition cost of \$50,000 or more;
- (b) to take such actions to implement, administer, amend or extend any such agreement as in the opinion of the Director of Economic Development may be appropriate to implement the direction of Council for completion of each Project; and

- (c) to sign such other documents and take such other actions as, in the opinion of the Director of Economic Development, may be appropriate to implement the direction of Council for the completion of each Project.


Delegation


2. The Director of Economic Development may delegate the performance of any one or more of his or her functions under this By-law to one or more persons from time to time as the occasion requires and may impose conditions upon such delegation and may revoke any such delegation. The Director of Economic Development may continue to exercise any function delegated during the delegation.
