

By-law 2020-52

A By-law of the City of Greater Sudbury to Amend By-law 2017-5 being a By-law of the City of Greater Sudbury Respecting the Delegation of Authority to Various Officials of the City

Whereas Council for the City of Greater Sudbury deems it advisable to amend By-law 2017-5 being a By-law of the City of Greater Respecting the Delegation of Authority to Various Officers of the City of Greater Sudbury;

Now therefore Council of the City of Greater Sudbury hereby enacts as follows:

1. By-law 2017-5 being a By-law of the City of Greater Respecting the Delegation of Authority to Various Officers of the City of Greater Sudbury, as amended, is hereby further amended by repealing Section 3 of Schedule "B" to By-law 2017-5 of the City of Greater Sudbury, Community Safety Department, General and enacting, in its place and stead the following:

"9-1-1 Communications Agreements

3. The General Manager of Community Safety is delegated the authority to Execute 9-1-1 Communication Agreements with Local Phone Service Providers."


2. By-law 2017-5 being a By-law of the City of Greater Respecting the Delegation of Authority to Various Officers of the City of Greater Sudbury, as amended, is hereby further amended by repealing Section 19 of Schedule "C" and enacting, in its place and stead the following:

"Debt Write-Off


19. The Treasurer is delegated the authority to abandon and write off, in whole or in part, an amount or claim of the City which he deems to be uncollectible, provided such amount or claim, exclusive of interest, in any one instance does not exceed Thirty-five Thousand Dollars (\$35,000) or the monetary jurisdiction of the Superior Court of Justice - Small Claims Court, whichever is greater."

3. This By-law shall come into full force and effect upon passage.
