

Summary of Changes
made between January 2017 and March 20, 2017

GENERAL	
Section 1.1 - CONTEXT	In the fourth paragraph, delete reference to 'two' main watersheds (French and Spanish) and replace with 'three' main watersheds Vermilion, Wanapitei and Whitefish River.
Section 6.0 - LOCAL FOOD Section 1.4 – Vision Part II: Managing Growth and Change Preamble	Revised section to reflect use of the word 'local' vs 'community' or 'regional' where appropriate and other minor changes.
Section 7.3.1 – PARKS AND OPEN SPACE – Public Ownership	Add reference to 'community gardens' in Policy 3b Add reference to rain gardens, green infrastructure and rain capture in Policy 3h.
Section 8.4 – SURFACE WATER	Changes based on March 2017 discussions with MOECC, including: removal of references to phosphorus being of natural or human origin and to causal study; and references to soils and septic systems are removed to reflect that the principal authority for Part 8 in Greater Sudbury is the Sudbury & District Health Unit.
Section 21.95 - Site Specific Policies for the LEGION	Change made as per Council resolutions 90 and 90A1, as follows: "21.95 Notwithstanding anything to the contrary, the City will require the dedication of land for parks and recreational purposes as a condition of development or redevelopment for lands described as PIN 73579-0273, Parcels 18627 & 15636 S.E.S, Lot 129, Plan M-139, in Lot 1, Concession 3, Township of McKim, otherwise known as Royal Canadian Legion Branch 76. Payment-in-lieu of parkland dedication will not be accepted by the City. The City will ensure that such dedication will protect the views to Ramsey Lake."
Schedules - KELLY LAKE	Delete all instances of reference to "Kelley" Lake and replace them with references to "Kelly" Lake.
Section 19.5.1 - EXISTING BY-LAWS	Revise to reflect that there is one existing by-law vs multiple that are intended to be amended or rescinded. Proposed new wording: "Zoning By-law No. 2010-100Z, as amended, has been passed in order to implement this Plan. This Zoning By-law will be updated on a regular basis as this Plan is updated. Existing uses in compliance with Zoning By-law 2010-100Z, as amended, will be permitted.
Section 21.7.6 - LAKE PANACHE	Remove reference to the word 'Small'
Schedule – OS DESIGNATION	Garson – Coniston Road – width of designation was expanded to reflect actual size of the cemetery.
Appendices – Enhanced Management Lakes	Renamed Appendices A, B and C to Appendices X, Y, and Z
