By-law 2017-70

A By-law of the City of Greater Sudbury to Authorize Grants to the Ukrainian Seniors Centre and to Child Care Resources for the 2017 Calendar Year

Whereas, pursuant to Section 107 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25, Council may pass by-laws for grants to certain bodies for purposes in the interest of the City;

And Whereas the Council of the City of Greater Sudbury, as part of its budget deliberations approved certain grant allocations to certain non-profit community groups as being in the public interest;

Now therefore the Council of the City of Greater Sudbury hereby enacts as follows:

- **1.** Council for the City of Greater Sudbury hereby authorizes a grant to Child Care Resources by way of:
 - the use of the Gatchell Pool during the summer of 2017 for its summer programming, with charge only for life guard services; and
 - (c) assistance by City Staff in 2017 program registration at no charge.
- 2. Council of the City of Greater Sudbury hereby authorizes a grant to a value of \$2,000 to the Ukrainian Seniors' Centre, the holder of the Canadian Garlic Festival by way of supply and installation of signs and fencing required to close the northbound lanes of Notre Dame Avenue between Elm Street and Ste. Anne Street, Sudbury, in order to facilitate the holding of the 2017 Canadian Garlic Festival.
- 3. The General Manager of Community Development is hereby authorized to execute any agreements, amendments thereto and other documentation necessary to set out the terms on which any one or more of the grants will be provided.
- **4.** This By-law shall come into full force and effect upon passage.
