- Over 225 Written Submissions Received






### What questions does Phase 1 address?


- How will our population, employment and land use needs grow and change over the next 20 years?
- Do we have enough land set aside to meet our short, medium and long term needs?
- How can we provide a wide range of housing options to the community?
- How can we plan for an aging population?
- How can we continue to protect our watersheds, lakes and rivers?
- How can we support the creation of a local food system?
- How can we build our resilience to our changing climate?





## Population, Housing and Employment Projections







#### Source Water Protection



- OP policies must conform to the Source Protection Plan
- Affects development and public works within vulnerable areas
- Stormwater; water takings









## Lake Water Quality Management



- Site plan control on all shoreline lots
- 20m vegetation buffers on lakes
- No new unserviced lots on nutrient rich lakes or lake trout lakes over threshold







## Natural Heritage



- Minor house-keeping edits (e.g., adjacent lands definitions)
- OP policies conform to the PPS
- Importance of preconsultation

## Climate Change Adaptation






- New to the Provincial Policy Statement 2014
