By-law 2020-46

A By-law of the City of Greater Sudbury to Authorize a Multi-Year Governance Agreement in Conjunction with the Metrolinx Transit Procurement Initiative with the Ontario Ministry of Transportation

Whereas the Ontario Ministry of Transportation has launched the Metrolinx Transit Procurement Initiative (TPI) program to facilitate joint procurements of transit system vehicles, equipment, technology, facilities and related supplies and services;

And Whereas Council of the City of Greater Sudbury has determined it is appropriate to enter into a Multi-Year Governance Agreement Joint Transit Procurements Facilitated by Metrolinx in conjunction with the TPI program to participate in the cooperative purchasing of transit system vehicles, equipment, technology, facilities and related supplies and services;

Now therefore Council of the City of Greater Sudbury hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. The General Manager of Community Development is hereby authorized to execute the Multi-Year Governance Agreement for Joint Transit Procurements Facilitated by Metrolinx (the "Governance Agreement") effective as of April 1, 2019 for the purpose of purchasing certain transit system vehicles, equipment, technology, facilities and related supplies and services on an exclusive basis from suppliers selected pursuant to public procurement processes facilitated by Metrolinx, on terms and conditions set out in the relevant procurement documents and in the Governance Agreement between, among others, Metrolinx and the City of Greater Sudbury
- 2. The General Manager of Community Development is further authorized to execute any agreements amending the Governance Agreement and to exercise City's rights of early termination of its participation in the Governance Agreement in accordance with the second paragraph of Section 9.6 of the Governance Agreement.
- 3. The Director of Transit Services is hereby authorized to perform any action, and provide any required recommendations, instructions and approvals to complete the procurements within the scope of the Governance Agreement, to appoint Alternate Members to the Steering Committee to perform the above in their absence and to exercise the City's rights to terminate a procurement in accordance with the first paragraph of Section 9.6 of the Governance Agreement.
- **4.** Every delegation of a power, duty or function includes all authority necessary to do all acts required to carry out the authority delegated under this By-law.

5. This By-law comes into effect upon passage.
